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

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A True Football Pioneer

FREDERICK DOUGLASS "FRITZ" POLLARD SPENT A LIFETIME BREAKING BARRIERS.

As both a coach and player, Fritz Pollard was the first African American coach in the National Football league, first African American to lead his team to a championship, and one of the first two African American players in the NFL.

Fritz Pollard was enshrined in the National Football Hall of Fame in 2005. Today, his legacy is embodied in the vision, mission, and continued work of the Fritz Pollard Alliance Foundation.



About the Fritz Pollard Alliance Foundation

The Fritz Pollard Alliance is an advocacy organization committed to driving diversity and equal opportunities for minorities in the National Football League. The organization provides benefits, resources, and thought leadership to individuals and teams across all levels of the NFL.

In 2003, civil rights lawyers Cyrus Mehri and the late Johnnie L. Cochran, Jr published a report highlighting the lack of opportunities for black head coaches in the NFL despite a superior performance record. As a result, with the input of Mehri and Cochran, the NFL implemented what is commonly known as the Rooney Rule, which requires teams to interview at least two minority candidates for head coach and general manager positions.

With the implementation of the rule, Mehri and Cochran, along with former NFL player and activist, John Wooten and an influential group of volunteers, formed the Fritz Pollard Alliance.

head coaches in 2024 were minorities, the most in league history.

7 NFL Clubs are Lead

by minority Team Presidents, including three women.

Super Bowl XLI

marked the first time two black coaches faced each other in a Super Bowl. Since 2007, 12 teams have reached the Super Bowl with a minority black head coach or GM. Prior to 2003, none had made it.

The Rooney Rule

Was implemented at the inception of the Fritz Pollard Alliance: requires at least (2) minority candidate be interviewed for head coaching and general manager positions.

28% of all NFL GM's

are minorities. Five years ago, it was 3%.
